CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MEAFORD**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS  
TO ENFORCE BY-LAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MEAFORD**

**WHEREAS** Section 15 (1) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15, authorizes municipal councils to appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS** Section 15 (2) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15, designates Municipal Law Enforcement Officers as Peace Officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws; and

**WHEREAS** Section 15 (1) of the Provincial Offences Act R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33 empowers Provincial Offences Officers to issue parking tickets; and

**WHEREAS** Section 26 of the Provincial Offences Act R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33 states that a summons shall be served by a Provincial Offences Officer; and

**WHEREAS** the Solicitor General of Ontario has designated all Municipal Law Enforcement Officers as Provincial Offences Officers as referenced on Schedule "B" to this By-law.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Meaford ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the Contract Personnel as retained from time to time and the Employees of the Municipality of Meaford for the provision of Municipal Law Enforcement services, are Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the purpose of enforcing the By-laws of the Municipality of Meaford.
2. THAT the persons designated as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers are set out on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
3. THAT Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" attached hereto form part of this by-law.
4. THAT if the provisions of this by-law conflict with the provisions of any other by-law, the provisions of this by-law shall prevail.
5. THAT By-law 65-03 passed October 20, 2003, By-law 33-2004 passed April 19, 2004, and By-law 66-2006 passed May 8, 2006 are hereby repealed.
6. THAT this by-law shall take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
