Subject: Trowbridge St. Bridge Rehabilitation

Dear Property Owner/Resident

The Municipality of Meaford is undertaking a construction project in your area. We would like to share the following information regarding the project and how it may impact you.

Project Details

- Location(s):** Trowbridge Street Bridge over the Big Head River, located between Bayfield Street and Denmark Street.
- Schedule:** Start Date – June 15, 2020
Estimated Completion - November, 2020
- Scope:** Replacement of pavement on bridge and approaches; Concrete repairs to the structure; Replacement of barrier systems; Installation of sidewalk on north side of bridge; Centre pier repairs and scour protection; Watermain replacements.
- Consultant:** PLANMAC Engineering Inc.
- Contractor:** National Structures 2011 Inc.

How will the project impact you?

- Road Access:** The Bridge will be closed to all traffic during the construction period.
- It will be necessary to close portions of roadways and intersections on either side of the bridge during some construction activities however these closures will be no longer than necessary to complete the work.
- The Contractor will attempt to tidy the area as work progresses, but final restoration will occur near the end of the project.
- Waste Collection:** If your regular pick-up point for garbage and recycling is temporarily blocked by construction, the Contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling to a predetermined collection area.
- Please ensure house numbers are clearly labeled on all Garbage and Recycling Containers to avoid them getting misplaced during waste collection.



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- Water Services:** The scope of this project includes a replacement of a watermain, which may require shutting down water services temporarily. Notice of water shutdowns will be provided by letter at least 48 business hours in advance of water interruptions. As always, water supplied to your residence will be of the highest quality and safe to drink.
- Noise:** Residents and property owners should expect some noise during construction times.
- Dust:** Residents and property owners should expect dusty conditions during some construction activities however efforts will be made to reduce dust as much as possible,
- Vibration:** The possibility of vibrations due to compaction equipment during construction is not anticipated to be significant but residents should protect valuables that may be susceptible to damage as a result of vibration.
- Property:** The Municipality will not be responsible for owner installed items within the road allowance, such as sprinklers, landscaping, lamp posts, etc. If you have any of these items we would recommend that they be removed during the project if possible.
