The Emergency Control Group has decided to close all offices, facilities including the Meaford Public Library, and non-essential services beginning at noon today, March 16, 2020, until further notice. - Fines will be waived for items due during the closure.
- Library membership cards set to expire during the closure will be renewed.
- All holds will be held for patrons until re-opening.
