Email will include weekly schedule and additional information about your week at camp.

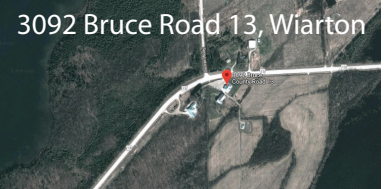
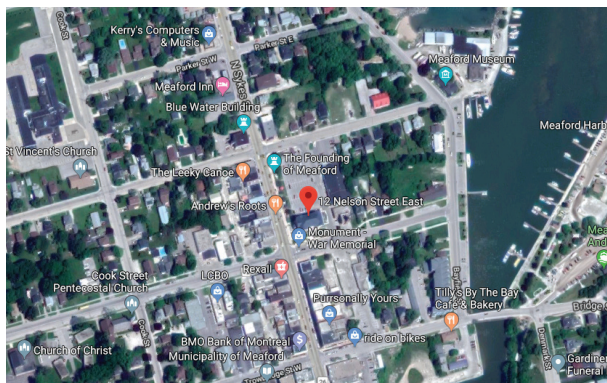
