

# Notice of Construction Bayshore Road Construction

April 29, 2024

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The Municipality of Meaford is undertaking a construction project in your area. We would like to share the following information regarding the project and how it may impact you.

## Project Details

<b>Location:</b>	Princess Street/Bayshore Road from Grey Road 15 to approximately 1km north.
<b>Schedule:</b>	Anticipated Start: <b>May 6, 2024</b> Estimated Completion: <b>July 2024</b>
<b>Scope:</b>	The reconstruction will include drainage work, repaving of the asphalt road, traffic calming infrastructure and some water servicing work.
<b>Funding:</b>	A portion of the funding for this project came from the Canada Community-Building Fund (formerly the Federal Gas Tax Fund). The Canada Community-Building Fund is a permanent source of federal funding for local infrastructure. <b>Contractor:</b>	Harold Sutherland Construction Ltd. (Walker Construction Grey-Bruce)

## How will the project impact you?

<b>Road Access:</b>	<p>The roadway is anticipated to be closed to through traffic, however residents and property owners will have access throughout construction except when it may be necessary to temporarily block entrances. The Contractor will communicate with impacted residents when an entrance is closed or blocked.</p> <p>It may be necessary to fully close the roadway during some construction activities however these closures should be of a short duration.</p> <p>We ask that you do not park on the roadway or boulevard during the construction.</p> <p>It is expected that your driveway will be accessible most of the time.</p> <p>The Contractor will attempt to tidy the area as work progresses, but final restoration will occur near the end of the project.</p>
<b>Waste Collection:</b>	If your regular pick-up point for garbage and recycling is temporarily blocked by construction, the Contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling to a predetermined collection area.

## Bayshore Road Construction

Please ensure house numbers are clearly labeled on all Garbage and Recycling Containers to ensure they are returned to the proper address.

- Water Services:** The scope of this project includes modifications to the existing water distribution system. Notice of water shutdowns will be provided by letter at least 48 business hours in advance of water interruptions. As always, water supplied to your residence will be of the highest quality and safe to drink.
- Noise:** Residents and property owners should expect some noise during construction.
- Dust:** Residents and property owners should expect dusty conditions during some construction activities however efforts will be made to reduce dust as much as possible.
- Vibration:** The possibility of vibrations due to compaction equipment during construction is not anticipated to be significant but residents should protect valuables that may be susceptible to damage because of vibration.
- Property:** The Municipality will not be responsible for owner installed items within the road allowance, such as sprinklers, landscaping, lamp posts, etc. If you have any of these items, we recommend that they be removed prior to the project if possible.
