

Structure 037 Rehabilitation

Dear Property Owner/Resident

The Municipality of Meaford is undertaking a construction project in your area. We would like to share the following information regarding the project and how it may impact you.

Project Details

Location: Highway 26 between Cook Street and Susan Street

Schedule: Anticipated Start: August 08, 2023

Estimated Completion: November 01, 2023

Scope: Rehabilitation of the Bridge including concrete repairs, repair of the deteriorated curb and extending the northeast pipe outlet, boulevard paving, removal and replacement of barrier system, reconstruction of the undermined northeast gabion baskets, erosion control and bank stabilization.

Consultant: Tatham Engineering Limited

Contractor: Nuroad Construction Limited

How will the project impact you?

Road Access: Two lanes of traffic will be maintained. Work will be completed within the boulevard and sidewalk locations.

It may be necessary to fully close the roadway during some construction activities however these closures should be of a short duration. The Contractor will attempt to tidy the area as work progresses, but final restoration will occur near the end of the project.

Property Access: Access to driveways and private property will be maintained.

Sidewalk Access: Access to the sidewalk will be closed during periods of construction. Please take note of signed sidewalk closures.

Waste Collection: If your regular pick-up point for garbage and recycling is temporarily blocked by construction, the Contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling to a predetermined collection area.

Please ensure house numbers are clearly labeled on all Garbage and Recycling Containers to ensure they are returned to the proper address.



- Noise:** Residents and property owners should expect some noise during construction times.
- Dust:** Residents and property owners should expect dusty conditions during some construction activities however efforts will be made to reduce dust as much as possible.
- Vibration:** The possibility of vibrations due to compaction equipment during construction is not anticipated to be significant but residents should protect valuables that may be susceptible to damage as a result of vibration.
