

Market Square Accessible Ramp Construction

The Municipality of Meaford is undertaking a construction project at the Market Square parking lot beside Meaford Hall that will impact 6 parking spaces in the Market Square. During construction, we ask that you park further away from the construction site. We would like to share the following information regarding the project and how it may impact you:

Project Details

Location:	Market Square Parking lot between Meaford Hall and the Big Apple
Schedule:	Anticipated Start: Tuesday, May 23, 2023 Estimated Completion: Friday, June 16, 2023
Scope:	Installation of fully accessible ramp and stairs front of Meaford Hall linking the sidewalk on Sykes Street to the Market Square parking lot. Landscaping, rerouting of electrical services and installation of 4 accessible parking spaces are also included.

How Will the Project Impact You?

Pre-Condition:	Seeley & Arnill will be marking utilities and setting up construction fencing near the work area in advance of construction.
Parking Lot Access During Construction:	The Market Square parking lot will be accessible from the usual entrances on Nelson Street and Collingwood Street. However, the area between the Big Apple and the Meaford Hall along Sykes Street will have construction equipment and activities present. About 1ft of sidewalk on Sykes Street will be inaccessible during this time. It may be necessary to close additional areas of the parking lot during some construction activities, however these closures should be of a short duration.

	<p>We ask that you do not park near the construction areas during the construction hours (7 AM – 7 PM Monday through Friday and 8 AM – 7 PM Saturday and Sunday).</p> <p>The Contractor will attempt to tidy the area as work progresses, but final restoration will occur near the end of the project.</p>
Noise:	Residents, property owners and businesses should expect some noise during construction times.
Dust:	Residents, property owners and businesses should expect dusty conditions during some construction activities. Efforts will be made to reduce dust as much as possible.
Vibration:	The possibility of vibrations due to compaction equipment during construction is not anticipated to be significant but residents should protect valuables that may be susceptible to damage as a result of vibration.
