Road Preventative Maintenance Program- Micro Surfacing

Dear Resident/Property Owner:

Duncor Enterprises, on behalf of the Municipality of Meaford, will be performing Micro Surfacing works on your street as part of the 2023 preventative maintenance program. Resurfacing is expected to begin about August 8, 2023 and be completed by September 1, 2023 and each road section is expected to be completed in about 2 days. During construction there will be lane restrictions and at times access may be limited. Duncor Enterprises will do their best to minimize disruptions while maintaining safety.

Micro Surfacing is a cost-effective preventative maintenance road surface treatment used to seal the pavement and improve its condition. Micro Surfacing is applied wet and contains asphalt cement and granite screenings for durability. It is designed to seal the road surface and extend the life of the roadway.

How You Can Help During the Work

To make things easier to complete the work and ensure the product seals properly we need your help. During the work:

- Do not park on the street the day of your planned slurry application. Generally, it will require only one day to complete the work on your street.
- Do not drive on the product immediately following the application of Micro Surfacing, as it takes about one hour to cure. Driving on the product during this time could damage the product and also result in Micro Surfacing becoming stuck to your vehicle.
- Do not park on your street for approximately 48 hours following the treatment, as this can damage the seal.
- Avoid dry steering, turning your wheels while stationary, on the fresh product as these actions may also cause damage.

Duncor employees will be in your neighborhood before the work begins with more specific information. More specific information on Micro Surfacing is available on our website at www.duncor.ca
