St. Vincent Street / Grey Road 7 Reconstruction

Dear Property Owner / Resident,

The Municipality of Meaford and Grey County are undertaking a construction project in your area. We would like to share the following information regarding the project and how it may impact you.

Project Details

Location: Grey Road 7 between Civic Address #500 St. Vincent Street and Muir Street.

Schedule: Anticipated Start: July 4, 2023
Estimated Completion: September 1, 2023

Scope: The work consists of rural and urban road reconstruction, curb & gutter, sidewalk repairs, road widening to install a left turning lane, removal and replacement of storm sewer and watermain pipes including structures and services, installation of new fire hydrants, hot mix paving, pavement markings and restoration of all disturbed areas.

Consultant: R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited

Contractor: Seeley and Arnill Construction

How will the project impact you?

Pre-Con Survey: OZA Inspections Ltd. (OZA) will be conducting a pre-condition survey to verify existing conditions for properties near the work areas. There is no cost to the residents or property owners. Additional details will be provided by OZA in a separate notice issued to residents to coordinate the surveys.

Road Access: Grey Road 7 within the project area will be closed to all traffic except for local traffic to access properties in the project area.

It may be necessary to fully close the roadway during some construction activities, however the contractor will make every effort to ensure access is available from either end of the work site. We ask that you do not park on the roadway or boulevard during the construction. It is expected that your driveway will be accessible unless work is being completed directly adjacent to your property.

The Contractor will attempt to tidy the area as work progresses, but final restoration will occur near the end of the project.

Waste Collection: If your regular pick-up point for garbage and recycling is temporarily blocked by construction, the Contractor will assist in collecting and transporting your garbage and recycling to a predetermined collection area.

Please ensure house numbers are clearly labeled on all Garbage and Recycling Containers to ensure they are returned to the proper address.

Water Services: The scope of this project includes a new watermain system which may require shutting down water services temporarily. Notice of water shutdowns will be provided by letter at least 48 hours in



advance of water interruptions unless an emergency watermain shutdown is required. As always, water supplied to your residence will be of the highest quality and safe to drink.

Other Services:

Bell Canada is completing works on their infrastructure along Grey Road 7 ahead of the municipal project.

Canada Post will be providing a community mailbox for residents with rural mailboxes. The temporary community mailbox will be located on McKibbin Drive.

Noise:

Residents and property owners should expect some noise during construction times.

Dust:

Residents and property owners should expect dusty conditions during some construction activities however efforts will be made to reduce dust as much as possible.

Vibration:

The possibility of vibrations due to compaction equipment during construction is not anticipated to be significant but residents should protect valuables that may be susceptible to damage because of vibration.

Property:

The Municipality will not be responsible for owner installed items within the road allowance, such as sprinklers, landscaping, lamp posts, etc. If you have any of these items, we recommend that they be removed prior to the project if possible.
