Stormwater Management System
2025 Annual Performance Report

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1. Introduction

The Stormwater Management System is owned and operated by the Corporation of the Municipality of Meaford. The storm system falls under the Environmental Compliance Approval (ECA) Number 089-S701, originally issued on November 17, 2022. This report is for the period of January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025.

This Annual Performance Report includes the following information:

2. Monitoring Data

There is no monitoring data for the report period as there are no instruments or equipment in the Stormwater Management System to provide data.

3. Environmental Trends

There are no trends for the reporting period of January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025, as there is no previous monitoring data to trend.

4. Operating Problems and Corrective Actions

No operating problems in this reporting period of January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025.

5. Inspection, Maintenance and Repairs

Standard inspection intervals occurred through Regulation 239/02. General maintenance occurred in some areas which included system clean out. This includes urban and rural storms systems.

6. Calibration and Maintenance

There were no calibrations or maintenance actions performed during the reporting period of January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025, as there is no monitoring equipment installed in the Stormwater Management System.

7. Complaints

Some minor complaints were received for poor drainage areas. These areas were inspected and evaluated and if required minor clean out of the system was preformed.

8. Alterations to the Authorized System

No areas of alteration occurred during this report period of January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025

9. Spills or Abnormal Discharge Events

There were no spills or abnormal discharge events during the reporting period of January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025.

10. Action Taken to Improve or Correct Performance

Continuous monitoring of system in occurrence of Regulation 239/02 timelines as outlined for each road classification. This will ensure minor system cleaning is captured before failure occurs.

11. Status of Action from Previous Years

There is no status of action for the reporting period of January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025, as there is no previous monitoring data.
