

# The Corporation of the Municipality of Meaford

## By-law Number 2018-32

---

### **Being a by-law to delegate authority for the removal of election adverts under Section 88.7 of the Municipal Elections Act**

**Whereas**, Section 5 (3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25 provides that municipal power shall be exercised by by-law; and

**Whereas**, Section 23.1 (1) of said Act permits a municipality to delegate its powers and duties under the Municipal Act or any other Act to a person or body, subject to the restrictions set out in the Municipal Act; and

**Whereas**, Section 88.7 of the Municipal Elections Act S.O. 1996, c.32 provides the Municipality with the authority to remove election advertisements that contravene sections 88.3, 88.4 or 88.5 of the Act; and

**Whereas**, Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Meaford deems it expedient and necessary to delegate the authority to remove election adverts in accordance with section 88.7 of the Municipal Elections Act to the Clerk/Returning Officer or their designate.

**The Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Meaford enacts as follows:**

1. That the Clerk/Returning Office, or their designate, is hereby authorized to exercise the powers and functions of the Municipality under section 88.7 of the Municipal Elections Act S.O. 1996, c.32.
2. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon being passed by Council.
