



WHAT IS IT?

It is an incentive program that encourages families to read 1000 books with their child before he or she enters senior kindergarten in school – a goal experts say children need to help them learn to read for themselves.

And it is **FREE** with your library card membership.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Starting September 11 2013, you can register for the program. Upon registration you will receive a beautiful 1000 Books Before Kindergarten journal as a keepsake of your journey. For every 100 books read, you will receive a small prize. If you read a book more than once (or over and over and over and yes, one more time...over again!), you can record it as a new entry in your journal. Titles can include any books that are read during Library Story Time on Wednesdays or by others to your child also count!

DID YOU KNOW?

If you only read three stories a day, then you and your child will
have read over 1000 books in one year.
