

Notice of Study Commencement and Public Information Centre for BR-125

Project Details

The pedestrian bridge identified as BR-125 is approaching the end of its useful service life and must be removed in order to maintain public safety. BR-125 has been determined to contain cultural heritage value within the local context. The Municipality of Meaford is evaluating various replacement or trail relocation options available to maintain access along the Georgian Trail, north of Edwin Street.

This assessment is being undertaken in accordance with the planning and design process for Schedule B projects, as outlined in the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2023) document, which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.
