NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

Public Notice Issued: May 7, 2026

Study Details:

The Municipality of Meaford has completed the study to identify the preferred replacement option for BR-125. Alternatives were evaluated for feasibility, cost, public and stakeholder input, and cultural heritage. A Notice of Study Commencement and Public Information Centre inviting public input was published on January 29, 2026.

This assessment has been undertaken in accordance with the planning and design process for Schedule B projects, as outlined in the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2023) document, which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.



Structure: BR-125 - Georgian Trail over Meaford Creek Pedestrian Bridge

Location: Georgian Trail, 12m north of Edwin Street (44°36'05. 5"N 80°35'13.6"W)

Preferred Alternative:

Through the evaluation of design alternatives and consultation with relevant agencies and the public, a preferred solution has been selected. The preferred solution involves removing the existing structure and rerouting the Georgian Trail onto the sidewalk of Edwin Street East and over Meaford Creek, utilizing the existing road bridge. A heritage plaque is to be erected to document and honour the cultural heritage that BR-125 possessed.
